People's assemblies

\* Residents groups.

(Resources for this kind of work)

Proposal to working group.

\* Libertarian network in every borough

\* Sustainability movement in every borough.

\* More solid in communities.

(Mapping) - what issues are going on in London? what's the common ground?

\* Community mobilisation - engaging with each other's political critique. (REGION/BOROUGH NATIONAL)

\* Capacity concerns

\* (Talking to lots of groups, get ideas, educate ourselves) - Proposal Education day, how we organise

\* Local + community are different. (community can be based on identity local can be work/home/etc)

\* How to get different ethnic groups more involved - more experience in organising what we're trying to do. System disengages people.

\* Open source technology facilitates exchange of ideas

\* Reclaiming space (we don't have space to talk, events)

\* Support other local campaigns ~~to support~~ - connection will open minds to thinking about climate change.

\* Finding common ground to share struggle.

\* Project developing between re-regal + monitoring group - other groups coming together.

\* Building systematically.

\* Getting involved with existing struggles.

# LOCAL

- Work with communities directly impacted by fossil fuel economy (e.g. London City Airport). Find these points of struggle + get stuck in. Important to be strategic.
- Discussion on should we focus on 'climate campaigns' or others. ~~Feelings~~ Feeling that this is a continuum not ~~an~~ an 'either/or'!
- 'Transition Heathrow' given as an example. Created a structure/space for people with different politics/priorities to work together. Activists ~~that~~ ~~heathrow~~ worked from issues found in the community.
- Important to start with 'what people want'!
- " to leave/develop an empowered community - that is the marker of success.
- 'William Morris Gallery' given as an example of how to link local + global; environmental; democratic; social issues in a local campaign.

• Strength of local campaigns that community is:

- connected
- static / stable
- committed
- have interest in success.



• Important to focus on a handful of campaigns - ~~to~~ CCamp Ldn focussing on too many campaigns could dissipate energy.

• Suggestion to have CCamp Ldn working group finding suitable local campaigns.

• Important to liase / talk to local groups in the area before deciding what to focus on.

• Good, solid foundation for a campaign is vital.

• Potential for strategic intervention by CCampers in transition towns movement.

# Politics 🇬🇧

We haven't discussed our political analysis.  
People think we are a direct action lobby group.

Many people have an aversion to 'politics'  
Mustn't alienate - as important as those w/  
political agendas.

Should we set up an educational session? Make it  
easy to understand.

More empowering to have a good vocabulary.

Amorphous concept. - we carry political message through  
actions. Do we need organisation-wide.

Can educate each other & set up a process.

Tim: Proposal - agree key aspects of CAPITALISM?  
Growth, Privatisation, Profit Motive / Free Markets.

People uncertain of this? Could be a structure.  
Could undermine what CC is about. Can we decide  
such a termant? Is a forum better.

Not defining, must find a PROCESS.

Shouldn't too narrowly define CC's politics. But maybe  
now well too broad.

Instead of a DEFINITION, provide a space to have  
discussions.

Don't want it to be academic intellectual debate, but  
similar to our other actions - film nights &

Also - anarchist background not talked about.

Kingsnorth - workshops. 120 - many people see them as  
a bolstee instead of important space themselves.

We have found a way of keeping discussion open.

- 2 things to decide

What should we feed into Nat. Process?

How should we do that for London neighbourhood?

Important to stay in large groups - get lots of people involved

- don't fragment the group

- people volunteer histories

- What does it mean to normal people if target a power station?

**Proposal** → large forums for discussion - presentation in London every Tuesday, 2 mins - what were about politically? eg anti-face market politics. 5 mins discussion

Action Point - Robin send out message to workshops to see if they want to add anything.

There has been a proposal to drop politics & conc on Climate emissions

**Proposal** → need to reaffirm principals, but need to clarify languages  
↳ working group to organise educational discussion sessions based on popular models & as accessible open forums, linked to actions where possible

**Proposal** → break down capitalism into smaller accessible chunks

Do not disappear up our asses! Share with others to put into action esp. alienated groups

**PROPOSAL** → London outreach event, evenings entertainment as accessible as possible.

Be careful of others belief - education can reach everyone

Musn't create exclusionary space - we aren't all in one place - change doesn't work to put out a fire if all in one space
